

Cabin "Calvin" Wilson, WWI Code Talker

Cabin (Calvin) Wilson was born June 25, 1895, at Eagletown, Eagle County, Choctaw Nation, Indian Territory. He was a member of the 142nd Infantry, Company E. Corporal Wilson and some of the other Code Talkers were demobilized from Camp Bowie.

Wilson continued to be a community leader when he returned to McCurtain County. Wilson donated land for the Panki Bok Presbyterian Church near Eagletown. He is buried at the small cemetery next to the church. The Congressional Medal for his family was accepted by his eldest granddaughter, Margaret McWilliams.
