

Cusher, Aaron

T-5 Aaron Cusher died in France on August 4 1944 of wounds received in action at Basse-Normandie, France. A full-blood Choctaw, he was born at Beachton to Mr. and Mrs. Pete E. Cusher, Beachton, Oklahoma in 1921 and had resided there throughout his life except when in school or in the Army. He volunteered for duty with the infantry before Pearl Harbor, and had been overseas more than a year, mainly in England before going to France. He attended schools at Beachton, Smithville, Bacone College, and Dwight Indian School in Vian. He left school to volunteer. He is buried in the American Cemetery in Normandy, France.
