Neal served as a Radio Operator CNS 759.

He qualified as Sharpshooter pitton, October 18, 1943

Battles and campaigns included China Offensive GO 81 WD 45 and China Defensive GO 75 WD 45. The military paperwork lists Neal's overseas duty from March 19, 1945 to November 6, 1945.

Neal's family stated that he served with the Flying Tigers, providing ground support. His Flying Tiger patch is sewed on the shoulder of his military jacket. The family retains Neal's military jacket, complete with decorations, stripes and ribbons.

Neal was decorated with the AP theater Ribbon with two bronze service stars; Good Conduct Medal; WWII Victory Ribbon and the American Theater Ribbon.

Oct 9, 1942 through November 15, 1945 is Neal's dates of service. His discharge was from Camp Chaffee, Arkansas
